1. 私密性与可达性 (Privacy & Accessibility):

- **私人堡垒，谢绝参观：**与公共建筑不同，这是一栋私人住宅 (Private Residence)，位于格鲁吉亚首都第比利斯市郊的 Okrokana 区。

1. Privacy & Accessibility

- **Private Fortress, No Visitors:** Unlike public buildings, this is a **Private Residence** located in the Okrokana district on the outskirts of Tbilisi, Georgia.
