

## CIBC 广场 (CIBC Square)

☀️ 探访指数: 4.5 / 5.0 | 💎 缝合金融区与滨水走廊的“钻石”

### 📖 空间故事

- **天际线上的钻石切割：** 在多伦多市中心林立的平庸玻璃幕墙写字楼中，由英国 WilkinsonEyre 建筑事务所操刀的 CIBC 广场犹如两颗熠熠生辉的钻石。建筑立面采用了极具辨识度的菱形 (Harlequin) 玻璃面板排列，随着太阳角度的推移与天光的变幻，这座巨大的几何体量会折射出如同水波般灵动的光影，彻底打破了传统摩天大楼的沉闷感。
- **跨越铁轨的空中绿洲：** 这不仅是一组摩天大楼，更是一项极具野心的城市缝合工程。两座塔楼之间，建筑师极其大胆地在多伦多最为繁忙的联合车站 (Union Station) 铁路走廊正上方，架设了一座占地一英亩的高架景观公园 (The Park)。这片悬浮的绿洲将长期被铁轨物理割裂的传统金融区与南部的安大略湖滨水区完美地连接在了一起。
- **隐匿的超级交通枢纽：** 作为 TOD (以公共交通为导向的开发) 的教科书级案例，建筑底部以极其优雅的方式吞吐着庞大的城市客流。它内部整合了全新的联合车站公交总站 (Union Station Bus Terminal)，并通过封闭的空中连廊与地铁网无缝对接，将复杂杂乱的交通基础设施化作了明亮、高效且充满

艺术感的现代大堂。

## 旅人行囊

-  **绝佳体验：** 在傍晚时分，搭乘电梯直达位于铁轨上方的高架公园（The Park）。找一张长椅坐下，在被精心挑选的绿植环绕中，看着脚下穿梭的列车与不远处 CN 塔的灯光亮起，感受多伦多跳动的城市脉搏。
-  **行家看点：** 重点研读其幕墙节点与结构工程。观察菱形玻璃表皮是如何在平整的室内空间与极具雕塑感的室外轮廓之间取得平衡的；同时，体察在不中断底层密集火车运行的前提下，架设空中公园所展现出的极致结构学造诣。
-  **顺道探索：** 既然已经身处多伦多的交通与商业心脏，你可以直接通过室内连廊步入历史悠久的联合车站（Union Station）感受布杂艺术（Beaux-Arts）大厅的宏伟，随后向南步行前往安大略湖畔，体验多伦多充满活力的滨水公共空间。

## 交通建议

- **绝对核心枢纽：** 多伦多联合车站（Union Station）是抵达这里的完美终点。
- **全方位接驳：** 无论你是从多伦多皮尔逊国际机场搭乘 UP Express 机场快线，还是乘坐 TTC 城市地铁（1 号线）、GO

Transit 城际列车，只要抵达 Union Station，无需走到室外，通过宽敞明亮的地下或空中连廊（PATH 系统）即可直接步入 CIBC 广场的大堂。

- **公交直达：** 联合车站公交总站（Union Station Bus Terminal）就直接镶嵌在 CIBC 广场的裙楼内部，乘坐长途巴士抵达这里的旅客，下车即是终点。

💡 **一言蔽之：** *用闪耀的菱形玻璃立面与极具魄力的跨铁轨高架公园，在多伦多的心脏地带，优雅地缝合了城市天际线与复杂的交通基础设施。*

## CIBC Square

☀️ **Architectural Visit Index: 4.5 / 5.0** | 💎 *The "Diamond"*  
*Twin Towers Stitching the Financial District to the Waterfront*

### 📖 Spatial Story

- **A Diamond Cut in the Skyline:** Amidst the forest of conventional glass-box office buildings in downtown Toronto, CIBC Square, designed by UK-based WilkinsonEyre, shines like two brilliant diamonds. The facade features a highly recognizable diamond

(harlequin) pattern of glass panels. As the sun's angle shifts and the sky changes, this massive geometric volume reflects light with the dynamic fluidity of water ripples, completely shattering the monotony of traditional skyscrapers.

- **An Elevated Oasis Over the Tracks:** This is not merely a set of skyscrapers; it is a highly ambitious urban suturing project. Between the two towers, the architects audaciously constructed a one-acre elevated landscaped park directly over the bustling rail corridor of Union Station. This suspended oasis perfectly reconnects the traditional financial district and the Lake Ontario waterfront to the south, which had long been physically severed by the railway tracks.
- **A Hidden Mega Transit Hub:** Serving as a textbook example of Transit-Oriented Development (TOD), the base of the building elegantly manages massive urban passenger flows. It seamlessly integrates the new Union Station Bus Terminal within its podium and connects directly to the subway network via enclosed skybridges. It transforms complex and historically chaotic

transportation infrastructure into a bright, efficient, and art-filled modern lobby.

### **Traveler's Toolkit**

-  **Ultimate Experience:** In the early evening, take the elevator up to The Park, the elevated green space spanning the railway tracks. Find a bench amidst the carefully curated greenery, and watch the trains weaving below and the lights of the nearby CN Tower turn on, feeling the pulsating heartbeat of Toronto.
-  **Expert Focus:** Carefully study the facade detailing and structural engineering. Observe how the harlequin glass skin balances flat, practical interior spaces with a highly sculptural exterior profile. Furthermore, appreciate the extreme structural mastery required to build an elevated park over active rail lines without disrupting the intense train traffic below.
-  **Itinerary Addition:** Since you are already at the transportation and commercial heart of Toronto, you can walk directly through the indoor corridors to the historic Union Station to experience the grandeur of its Beaux-Arts Great Hall. Then, take a short stroll south to

the shores of Lake Ontario to experience Toronto's vibrant waterfront public realm.

### **Getting There**

- **The Ultimate Hub:** Union Station in Toronto is the perfect arrival point for this destination.
- **Seamless Connectivity:** Whether you are taking the UP Express from Toronto Pearson International Airport, the TTC Subway (Line 1), or the GO Transit intercity trains, once you arrive at Union Station, you can walk directly into the CIBC Square lobby via the spacious and bright indoor PATH network without ever having to step outside.
- **Direct Bus Access:** The Union Station Bus Terminal is literally built into the podium of CIBC Square. For travelers arriving by regional bus, stepping off the coach means you have already arrived.

💡 **In a Nutshell:** *With its shimmering diamond-patterned glass facade and a bold elevated park spanning the rail corridor, it elegantly stitches together the urban skyline and complex transit infrastructure in the heart of Toronto.*
