总分: 3.0/5.0 (科威特沙漠中的雕塑堡垒)

1. 私密性与可达性 (Privacy & Accessibility):

1. Privacy & Accessibility

- **Private Mansion, No Visitors:** This is a **Private Mansion** located in the Abdullah Al-Salem neighborhood of Kuwait, with a massive floor area of 1,788 square meters. 3. Wisdom of Desert Climate

- **Introverted Oasis:** The heart of the house is a lush courtyard and swimming pool. All rooms revolve around this oasis, wrapping a microclimate within the desert.
- **Filter of Light:** Light-colored stucco and stone facades reflect intense sunlight, while layered vegetation filters the light, casting lively shadows indoors. This is a modern interpretation of ancient wisdom for creating comfortable living environments in extreme climates.

Visitor Guide

- **Best Way to Visit:**
 - **Digital Tour:** It is recommended to view its photography on Archicasting or Alhumaidhi Architects' official website. Focus on the central courtyard and how the soft curves guide the spatial flow.
- **Alternative Experiences:**
