Project: House in Nishishinmachi Design Team: TYdo architects Size: 181.10 m² Location: Iwata City, JAPAN

Project - Nestled in a residential neighborhood of Iwata City, Shizuoka, the House in Nishinmachi by Yosuke Takatsuka / TYdo architects reinvents the traditional boundaries between public and private realms. Situated on a corner plot facing a school route, the architects devised an ingenious RC concrete wall that curves around the ground floor private quarters, deftly balancing privacy with considerations for pedestrian flow.

This sculptural "fence" envelops the site, thoughtfully integrating planter boxes and rounded corners to facilitate seamless movement. Its interior forms an enclosed exterior space for activities like sauna cool-downs, heightening the sense of seclusion. Unified with the projecting eaves, the wall's slit apertures create a striking play of light and shadow.

Upstairs, the open-plan living area is gently delineated through ceiling height variations and two balconies that blur indoor/outdoor boundaries. These semi-outdoor living extensions enhance cross ventilation and daylighting while reinforcing their distinctive purposes.

Yosuke Takatsuka reflects, "We constantly explore what constitutes a universally enriching lifestyle here, keeping in mind the community, customs and climate shaped by regional events." This seventh project within 1km of their lwata office exemplifies TYdo's localized approach to architectural placemaking.
