Project - Perched atop stilts amidst the treetops, Residence Chez Léon by Quinzhee

Architecture immerses inhabitants in the sublime nature of Charlevoix, Quebec while

treading lightly on the landscape. The clients envisioned a contemporary chalet

harmoniously integrated within its forested environs yet leaving a minimal ecological

footprint.

From the approach, refined volumes clad in cedar rise gracefully, punctuated by expansive

south-facing windows that bathe the interior in warm natural light. The suspended main

level containsliving spaces that open completely to framed vistas of the St. Lawrence River,

while strategically screened openings on the side offer a sheltered vantage point to immerse

in the sights and sounds of the mountainous setting.

A grounded concrete monolith housing the entrance separates from the primary volume,

its mass symbolically rooting the airy residence. Upstairs, the centralized stairwell and

corridor form a transitional threshold between the communal areas and private bedrooms,

visually connecting front and rear viewsheds.

Prioritizing efficient construction and sustainable strategies, the architects employed highly

insulated double-framed walls, meticulously bridged insulation, and an energy-efficient

HVAC system. With restrained spaces and untreated materials, Chez Léon evokes nostalgic

treehouse whimsy reinterpreted through an environmentally conscious contemporary lens.
