

旅游探访指数 - 时间之屋

总分：4.5/5.0 (厄瓜多尔河畔的红砖慢生活庇护所)

1. 私密性与租住体验:

这是一座位于厄瓜多尔巴瓦霍约河畔的建筑，面积约一百八十平方米。假设你能够将其作为度假屋租住，它将为你提供一种彻底对抗现代加速逻辑的“慢生活”体验。房屋以中央庭院为核心，既能向内收拢提供极佳的私密栖居感，又能向着河流敞开，让你完全沉浸在充满南美风情的河畔日常之中。

探访指南

- **看点:** 仔细触摸并品味建筑里那些质朴的在地工艺，看本地木材制成的横梁是如何向外延伸变成抵御暴雨的巨大顶盖，看红砖是如何在不同光线下展现出丰富且粗犷的物质肌理的。
- **项目周边顺带探访推荐:** 既然你来到了巴瓦霍约这座河流城市，千万不要错过探索其独特的水上文化。极力推荐你租乘一艘传统的细长木舟，沿着巴瓦霍约河去探访当地著名的水上传统浮屋群体。这种原始而充满生命力的水上栖居方式，与你租住的时间之屋在精神上遥相呼应，将为你拼凑出一幅最完整的厄瓜多尔水乡文化拼图。

1. Privacy & Rental Experience:

Located along the Babahoyo River in Ecuador, this property spans approximately 180 square meters. The local architectural team avoided mechanical air conditioning, turning the entire house into an apparatus highly sensitive to natural rhythms. You can feel the shallow pool in the courtyard quietly regulating the tropical humidity, while the delicate wooden lattices block the glaring equatorial sun and draw in cool cross-breezes. As the sun moves throughout the day, the skylights choreograph a continuous flow of light and shadow across your living space.

3. Ultimate Local Handcrafted Brick Aesthetics:

You will hardly find any standardized industrial building materials here. Red bricks fired by local artisans act as a

universal module, forming walls, floors, and even clever interior lighting fixtures. The river-facing design is particularly ingenious: the courtyard walls fold open completely to become a projection screen, while the terraced platform extending toward the water can transform into your private open-air waterfront theater.

Visitor Guide

- **Best Way to Visit:** It is highly recommended to fully open the folding walls facing the inner courtyard at dusk. You can turn this into a semi-outdoor private screening room, or simply grab a drink, sit on the terraced platform by the river, and enjoy the evening breeze of the tropical river network, experiencing the seamless integration of architecture and nature.
- **Highlights:** Carefully touch and appreciate the rustic local craftsmanship—observe how the local timber beams extend outward to form a massive protective canopy against rainstorms, and see how the red bricks reveal rich, rugged material textures under different lighting conditions.
- **Recommended Nearby Visit:** Since you are in the river

city of Babahoyo, do not miss exploring its unique aquatic culture. It is highly recommended to rent a traditional slender wooden canoe and paddle along the Babahoyo River to visit the famous local traditional floating houses. This raw and vibrant aquatic way of living resonates spiritually with the House of Time you are renting, completing a perfect cultural mosaic of the Ecuadorian water town.
