Project - Nestled in the lush canopies of Wenzhou, the new Wenzhou Medical University International Exchange Center by FCJZ masterfully embraces its mild climate. Split into eight 4-story buildings, including dorms, an activity center, library, classrooms and lecture hall, the complex balances openness and enclosure. Continuously projecting roofs form an abstract foliage veil, pierced only by courtyards and "sky slits." These 50cm gaps admit light and rain to gray spaces between indoors and outdoors. Verandas sheltered under 10m deep eaves create shaded semi-outdoor rooms. Students and faculty can fluidly transition between the central courtyard, conditioned interiors, verandas and umbrella-like cantilevers as the weather fluctuates. FCJZ intends for the center's ambiguous boundaries to attune users to Wenzhou's climate, while offering both privacy and venues for collective gatherings. Simple concrete frames retain the material's raw texture. Overall, the dialogue between architecture, climate and nature fosters a rich sensory experience.
