

## 旅游探访指数 - 反坡住宅

总分：3.0/5.0 (向地形致敬的林间隐居之所)

### 1. 私密性与可达性:

- 这是一座位于加拿大魁北克省波顿地区梅姆弗雷马戈格湖南岸的私人住宅。由于其私人属性和隐秘的陡坡位置，普通游客无法进入内部参观，更适合通过建筑媒体进行云端赏析。

### 2. 顺应地形的反坡哲学:

- 面对陡峭且常年被山影笼罩的地形，蒙特利尔的设计团队放弃了粗暴的场地改造。建筑被拆分为两个相互关联的片段式体量，独特的“反坡”屋顶设计悄然呼应着周围连绵的山地几何，让整座住宅如同从原始坡地中自然生长出来一般，充满谦逊的退隐感。

### 3. 屋顶露台的景观仪式:

- 住宅最具诗意的一笔，是将主体体量的屋顶转化为一处观景高台。在倾斜的场地上，这片珍贵的水平面不仅是进入室内的必经之路，更像是一台天然的视觉仪器。配合着外立面自然风化的雪松木和室内温暖的白橡木，大面积的落地玻璃将湖景毫无保留地切入起居生活，实现了建筑与自然的完美协同。

## 探访指南

- **最佳方式:** 强烈推荐通过专业的建筑剖面图与摄影大片来解构这栋住宅，重点研究它如何利用极其克制的黑色构件，像电影镜头一般精准地框取不同层次的湖岸风景。
- **看点:** 仔细观察那历经风吹日晒的雪松木外皮，体会建筑师如何利用材料的自然老化过程，让一栋新建的四百二十平方米住宅完美融入湖畔的矿石与植被色彩之中。

**一句话总结:** 它用退让与谦逊的姿态将自己缝合进魁北克的陡峭山体之中，把屋顶化作眺望湖面的高台，完成了一场关于居住与自然的深刻沉思。

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## Travel & Visit Index - Counter-Slope House

### 1. Privacy & Accessibility:

- This is a private residence located on the southern shore of Lake Memphremagog in Potton, Quebec, Canada. Due to its private nature and secluded location on a steep slope, the interior is not open to the public, making it best suited for a digital tour via

architectural media.

## **2. The Counter-Slope Philosophy Responding to Terrain:**

- Faced with a steep site frequently cast in mountain shadows, the design team eschewed brutal site modifications. The building is fragmented into two interrelated volumes. The unique "counter-slope" roof design quietly echoes the surrounding angular mountain geometries, allowing the entire residence to feel as though it naturally grew out of the pristine hillside with a profound sense of humble retreat.

## **3. Landscape Ritual on the Roof Terrace:**

- The most poetic stroke of the residence is the transformation of the main volume's roof into an elevated belvedere terrace. On a site dominated by a downward slope, this rare horizontal plane acts not only as an entrance threshold but also as a natural visual instrument. Paired with naturally weathered cedar on the exterior and warm white oak inside, expansive floor-to-ceiling glass draws the lake views unreservedly into the living spaces,

achieving perfect harmony between architecture and nature.

## **Visitor Guide**

- **Best Way to Visit:** It is highly recommended to deconstruct this residence through professional architectural sections and photography, focusing on how it uses highly restrained black architectural elements to frame multi-layered shoreline views with cinematic precision.
- **Highlights:** Closely observe the weathered cedar cladding to understand how the architects utilized the material's natural aging process to seamlessly blend a newly built, 420-square-meter residence into the mineral and vegetal tones of the lakeshore.

**One-Sentence Summary:** Suturing itself into the steep Quebec mountainside with a gesture of humility and concession, it turns its roof into a viewing platform over the lake, completing a profound meditation on dwelling and nature.
