

## 旅游探访指数 - 光之屋

总分：3.5/5.0 (堆叠在阿姆斯特丹新区的玻璃光盒)

### 1. 私密性与可达性:

- 这是一座位于荷兰阿姆斯特丹中心岛新区的私人住宅，建筑面积两百五十七平方米。由于其为私人居所，建筑内部并不对公众开放，游客只能在宁静的街区外部欣赏其独特的半透明玻璃立面与错落的建筑体量。

### 2. 打破常规的垂直生活:

- 荷兰本土的建筑团队彻底颠覆了传统住宅将生活功能集中于首层的做法，将用餐、聚会、独处等不同场景分配到了相互错落的盒状空间中。在这个垂直交织的体系里，上下、内外的空间界限被悄然消弭，赋予了日常起居一种极度流动且充满探索趣味的体验。

### 3. 光线作为建筑核心语言:

- 建筑下半部被方形的玻璃砖墙紧紧包裹，不仅将充沛的自然光引向室内深处，更以恰到好处的朦胧感过滤了街道的视线。从外部看，室内生活化作了一幅抽象而灵动的剪影。而到了顶层，高达十四米的家庭聚会室配备了巨大的拱形落地窗，将附近开阔的湖景毫无保留地纳入了这处私家庇护所。

## 探访指南

- **最佳方式:** 极其推荐在傍晚时分前往该街区进行外部建筑漫步。此时，玻璃砖墙会透出室内温暖的灯光，与后部立面坚硬的钢格栅构件形成强烈的视觉张力，展现出极佳的工业美学气质。
- **看点:** 仔细观察其下半部的方形玻璃砖与上方轻型钢框架及预制木构件的巧妙结合。体会建筑师是如何摒弃传统混凝土，为这栋住宅注入了可拆解、可适应家庭未来成长的可持续建造智慧。

**一句话总结:** 它像一组被轻盈堆叠的半透明发光盲盒，在阿姆斯特丹的新区里，用玻璃砖与钢格架重塑了关于垂直生活的无限可能。

## **Travel & Visit Index - Light House**

**Total Score: 3.5/5.0 (A Glass Light Box Stacked in Amsterdam's New District)**

**1. Privacy & Accessibility:** This is a private residence located in the new Centrum district of Amsterdam, Netherlands, with a floor area of 257 square meters. As a private dwelling, the interior is not open to the public. Visitors can only appreciate its unique translucent glass

facade and staggered architectural volumes from the outside in this quiet neighborhood.

**2. Unconventional Vertical Living:** The local Dutch architectural team completely subverted the traditional residential practice of concentrating living functions on the ground floor. Instead, they distributed different scenarios—such as dining, gathering, and solitude—into staggered box-like spaces. In this vertically intertwined system, the spatial boundaries between up and down, inside and outside, are quietly dissolved, endowing daily life with an extremely fluid and exploratory experience.

**3. Light as the Core Architectural Language:** The lower half of the building is tightly wrapped in square glass brick walls, which not only draw abundant natural light deep into the interior but also filter street views with just the right amount of haziness. From the outside, indoor life is transformed into an abstract and dynamic silhouette. At the top level, a 14-meter-high family gathering room is equipped with massive arched floor-to-ceiling windows, unreservedly bringing the expansive nearby lake views into this private sanctuary.

**Visitor Guide**

- **Best Way to Visit:** An exterior architectural stroll through the neighborhood at dusk is highly recommended. At this time, the glass brick walls radiate warm interior lighting, creating a strong visual tension with the rigid steel grating components on the rear facade, showcasing an excellent industrial aesthetic.
- **Highlights:** Carefully observe the ingenious integration of the square glass bricks on the lower half with the lightweight steel frame and prefabricated timber components above. Experience how the architects abandoned traditional concrete to inject this residence with sustainable building wisdom that is demountable and adaptable to the family's future growth.

**One-Sentence Summary:** Like a set of lightly stacked, translucent glowing blind boxes, it uses glass bricks and steel gratings to reshape the infinite possibilities of vertical living in Amsterdam's new district.
