1. 私密性与可达性 (Privacy & Accessibility):

1. Privacy & Accessibility

- **Private Hidden Territory, No Visitors:** This is a **Private Residence** located in the congested Ladprao district of Bangkok, Thailand. Sunlight filtering through leaves casts dappled shadows indoors, creating a tranquility isolated from Bangkok's noise.

- **Vessel of Light:** The architecture is designed as a vessel to capture light. The central courtyard serves not only as a landscape core but also as a passive lighting system, allowing natural light to penetrate every corner of the interior, performing a magic show of light and shadow over time.

professional design websites like Archicasting or Designboom. Pay special attention to how the **curved glass** softens spatial boundaries and the dramatic scenes of trees piercing through the architecture.
