

旅游探访指数 - 纽约艺术家住宅与工作室

总分：3.0/5.0 (深藏于美洲原野的东方游园)

1. 私密性与可达性:

- 这是一座位于美国纽约州北部卡茨基尔山区的私人艺术家住宅兼工作室。由于其作为私人居所与独立创作阵地的双重私密属性，这片广袤的领地并不对公众开放参观，更适合通过专业媒体进行云端研读。

2. 东方游园与美洲荒野的碰撞:

- 来自中国的设计团队将古典园林中“游园”的空间逻辑巧妙植入了这片美洲森林。建筑体块被非线性地穿插排布，体量之间自然生长出多个朝向各异的庭院。一条贯穿全宅的中央展廊既是动线，又是艺术品的展示长廊，完美回应了屋主艾米丽和沃尔夫的日常生活状态。

3. 谦逊退让的自然共生:

- 建筑以极度谦让的姿态融入土地。为了保护场地里的百年老树，局部采用了可以仰望星月的平屋顶；而为了应对当地冬季厚重的积雪，主体则采用了多折坡屋顶。浅色木材饰面与隔热混凝土交织，整座建筑会随着四季流转，与居住者一同优雅地老去。

探访指南

- **最佳方式:** 既然无法亲自步入, 建议你通过专业的建筑摄影与平面图进行深度赏析。重点感受那些在不同体块间“留白”出的庭院, 是如何捕捉独特的光线质感并与周遭树木发生微妙互动的。
- **看点:** 细细品味设计背后的东方哲学立场——看建筑师如何用充满善意的场地连接方式, 在异国他乡的荒野中酝酿出一种关于岁月、自然与感官交融的诗意情绪。

一句话总结: 它不征服土地, 而是用东方园林的漫游智慧, 在纽约北部的风雪与百年老树之间, 写下了一首关于自然、艺术与时间共生的诗篇。

1. Privacy & Accessibility:

- Located in the Catskill Mountains of upstate New York, this is a private artist's residence and studio. Due to its highly private nature as both a home and an independent creative sanctuary, this expansive territory is not open to the public. It is best explored and studied

digitally through professional architectural media.

2. Collision of Eastern Garden and American Wilderness:

- The Chinese design team ingeniously embedded the spatial logic of "wandering in a classical garden" into this American forest. The architectural volumes are arranged in a non-linear, interlocking manner, naturally generating multiple courtyards facing different directions. A central gallery spine runs through the entire house, serving as both a circulation path and an exhibition space, perfectly reflecting the owners' daily lives as practicing artists.

3. Humble and Restrained Natural Symbiosis:

- The architecture integrates into the land with an attitude of extreme deference. To protect the century-old trees on the site, flat roofs were partially adopted to create terraces for stargazing. Meanwhile, to cope with the heavy winter snows, the main structure features multi-pitched roofs. Insulated concrete forms intertwine with light-toned timber finishes, allowing the entire building to shift subtly with the seasons and age gracefully alongside its inhabitants.

Visitor Guide

- **Best Way to Visit:** Since physical entry isn't possible, a deep appreciation through professional architectural photography and floor plans is highly recommended. Focus on how the "blank spaces" forming the courtyards between different volumes capture unique qualities of light and interact subtly with the surrounding trees.
- **Highlights:** Carefully savor the Eastern philosophical stance behind the design—observe how the architects used a goodwill connection to the site to cultivate a poetic mood of time, nature, and sensory integration in the wilderness of a foreign land.
